

"DILLER" PROPERTY CHRONOLOGY

<u>DATE</u>	<u>EVENT</u>	<u>ACTION</u>
14 March 1983	Inland Wetlands Commission Meeting	IWC denied the application to develop play fields on this site ["Diller" property] because of the impact on wetlands and watercourses and drainage questions.
21 March 1988	RTM Warning	Item First: report from 1st Selectman on the status of the negotiations re: proposed purchase of "Diller" property.
"	RTM Meeting	Item First: Sense of the Meeting motion to purchase the "Diller" property for open space passed - 55 in favor, 19 opposed, 9 abstentions. Virginia Oldrin, Chairman of the EPC, objected to suggestion that "wetlands are not beautiful".
26 September 1988	RTM Warning	Item Second: recommendation that the Town purchase the "Diller" property for "general town purchases".
"	RTM Meeting	Item Second: approval to purchase the "Diller" property "for open space use passed - 59 in favor, 19 opposed, 1 abstention.
20 October 1997	RTM Meeting	Item Third: approval to amend the use designated for the "Diller" property from open space to park and recreation purposes passed - 36 in favor, 27 opposed, 2 abstentions RTM member Linda Santarella, District III, noted the IWC action of 14 March 1983, and stated "since there are wetlands and watercourses, the EPC would play a key role in any proposed development of this site": she supported the amendment of usage.
