Please be advised that the Darien Police Commission, acting as the local Legal Traffic Authority for the Town of Darien, voted to endorse the application to install six "on street" parking spaces (five (5) standard, (1) Handicapped) on Nutmeg Lane adjacent to the Diller Property. This unanimous vote was taken at the Police Commission meeting held on April 30th, 2019 (meeting # 2365) with Commissioners Joyce, Huffard and Johnson in attendance.

The Commission had been advised of the following information for consideration:

- Being that the proposed walking/cross county track on the Diller Property will be open to the public, and parking on school grounds will not be available to the general public during normal school hours, some parking should be made available for public use.
- Parking on Nutmeg Lane is currently prohibited as parking on the roadway surface itself (absent the creation of "inset" spaces as proposed), causes unacceptable travel lane restrictions on Nutmeg Lane.
- An ADA compliant sidewalk will be reinstalled directly behind the proposed parking spaces.
- Parking will be time restricted with specific time limits (1 or 2 hour) to be determined; Darien High School students or staff should not be parking in these Nutmeg Lane spots during the school day.
