*W*HEREAS, environmental health professionals understand the connection between public health and the management of the environment; and

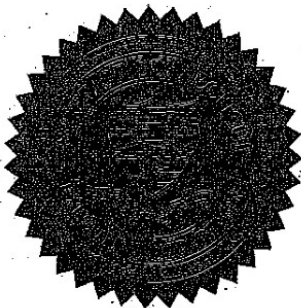

*W*HEREAS, environmental health professionals apply science and evidence-based expertise to mitigate known or potential problems, and this practical application of knowledge gained through many years of diligent study often results in the avoidance of significant health hazards; and

*W*HEREAS, environmental health professionals respond to natural disasters and human-made emergencies, and work with other professionals specializing in public health, emergency management, public safety, and health care to assist Connecticut communities in crisis; now
