

CT Medicare Savings Programs

The State of Connecticut offers financial assistance to eligible Medicare enrollees through the Medicare Savings Programs. These programs may help pay Medicare Part B premiums, deductibles and co-insurance.

If you qualify for one of the three Medicare Savings Programs (depending on your income), DSS will pay your Medicare Part B premium each month. In addition, some enrollees will be covered for Medicare deductibles and co-insurance. CT Medicare Savings Programs are funded by Medicaid.

Additional Low Income Medicare Beneficiaries (ALMB)*	\$2,617.44 per month	\$3,535.02 per month

*Due to federal funding limits, not everyone who qualifies for ALMB by income may receive coverage.
