A caring partner in service to our community and its residents

- **Counseling Support and Outreach** (including home visits) are available for seniors and their families during times of need.
- **Choices Counselors** are available to assist with Medicare Coverage, Medigap, Medicare Savings Programs and annual enrollment for Part D prescription plans.
- **Municipal Agent on Aging** serves as a liaison with the State Department Commission on Aging and other resources and programs serving seniors.
- **Senior Resource Directory** provides information about local and state services available to seniors.
- **Reassurance Call** provides peace of mind for the elderly or disabled during severe weather or other serious town-wide incidents.
- **Darien Veterans' Service Contact Person** serves as a liaison with federal, state and local agencies that serve veterans.
- **Loan Closet** provides free, short-term loans of durable medical equipment.
- **Financial Assistance** provides eligible seniors with direct financial aid for a specific need on a short-term basis.
- **Energy Assistance** provides eligible seniors with financial aid for home heating through state and local programs.
- **Renters Rebate** provides eligible seniors and disabled residents with a rebate on their yearly rental expense through a state-funded program.
- **Long-term Planning** helps adult children make housing and health care decisions for their parents or aging relatives.
- **Household Supply Closet** provides eligible seniors with cleaning supplies, paper goods and personal grooming products.
