Meeting was called to order at 7:30

This was a special meeting called to discuss the answers to questions that the committee gave to the BoE.

Discussion ensued regarding a question that was not explicitly answered by the BoE regarding the total number of outplaced students. It was mentioned that the number was given to the committee when Dr Landon was the Superintendent but while it is being considered now, the information has not been given to the committee. The committee does not want information that would be problematic in terms of identifying specific students but so that the committee can truly look at costs per student by knowing the exact number of students.

Discussion ensued regarding athletics and the fact that the deep dive the BoE had done the previous summer was mostly an examination of clubs and councils, not athletics.

There was then a discussion of balances held in team sports accounts and that there was no way to account for the monies held, disbursed and balances. There is a rule now that all balances over \$1,000 get swept at the end of the school year but it is unclear swept to where and for what purpose.

There was discussion the health care costs which have not been finalized yet as well as legal fees.

There was a lengthy discussion regarding the extra bus to transport students from an area in District 2 which is within the 2-mile bus radius but which has been raised as area of concern because of lack of sidewalks and construction areas which make it dangerous for students to walk to school.

There was then a discussion about the purchase of Open Gov by the administration which has been suggested by the BoF. The committee felt that the cost of adding Open Gov seemed very high especially when savings are key.

Lucy Fiore motioned for adjournment, seconded by Ed Washecka
