Vice-Chair Patrick called the meeting to order at 7:29 p.m. Voting on the Police Dept. Interagency Agreement had been postponed pending further legal review and was not discussed.

Discussion was held re the Transfer Station (the "dump") including need for more education, current lack of signs. Consideration should be given to asking Public Works for more direction. Further information may come from the Transfer Station Advisory Committee.

Discussion was held about the sidewalk issue (Hoyt), the general need for further safety issues, signs, absence of crosswalks in some areas, the risk to walkers, runners, and bikers **and** the lack of responsibility that some of the latter show. It was agreed that a tour of the new Police station would be worth while and that we should also meet with the police about the above issues.

Concern was expressed also about a perceived lack of safety re deer bow hunters.

Clearly there are enough issues for this committee to pursue.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:58 p.m.
