

Public Works Committee Meeting – Tuesday February 26th, 2013

Chairman Mark Adiletta called the February 26, 2013 meeting of the Public Works Committee, a sub-committee of the Darien RTM to order at 8:02pm.

In attendance were Patti Bumgardner, Katie Keith, Nina Miller, Steve Anderson, Thomas Moore, Jim Cameron, Joe Hardison, Allison Stolar and Janet Grogan. Tom Valentino, Frank Adelman and Richard Poli were absent.

Three motions were brought before the Public Work committee this evening.

- Motion 1: To approve the minutes of the January meeting subject to correcting one name typo.
- Motion 2: (Sense of the meeting) After reviewing the data gathered by the Darien Station Operation Subcommittee of the TSAC the PWC supports 1) increasing the commercial tipping fees for leaves, grass, brush and wood chips from the current level to prevailing current local market rates and 2) an increase to Residential Dump Permit fees to reflect the change in the consumer price index since Residential Dump Permit fees were last set.
- Motion 3: (Sense of the meeting) The PWC suggests limiting number of permits issued per household for a single Residential Dump Permit fee to two and to offer a third permit per household for an additional fee equal to ½ the applicable Residential Dump Permit fee.

All three motions passed unanimously. Jim Cameron abstained on the first motion.

Allison Stolar and Steve Anderson gave an extensive powerpoint presentation on Darien Transfer Station including their recommendations for the Board of Selectman. Please see the attached Transfer Station Operations documents for specific details.
