Meeting was called to order 7:31 PM by the Moderator.

Approval of the November 18, 2019 Minutes, with no changes, was moved by Mr. Davis, Mr. Wheeler second. Motion was approved unanimously.

Assignment to committees for new RTM members appointed 11/25/19 & 12/9/19 discussed next.

Mr. Kemp presented for District IV as follows:
