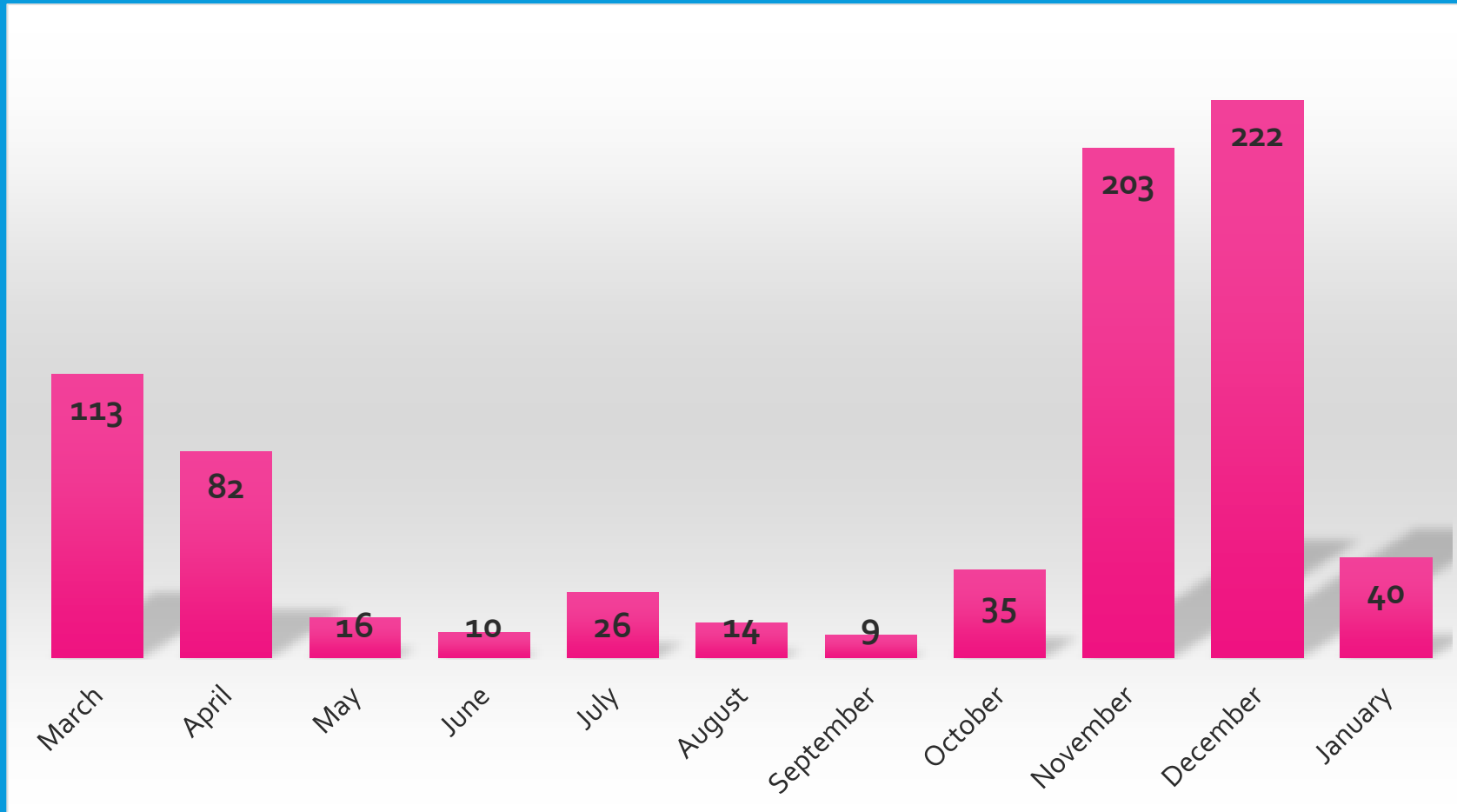

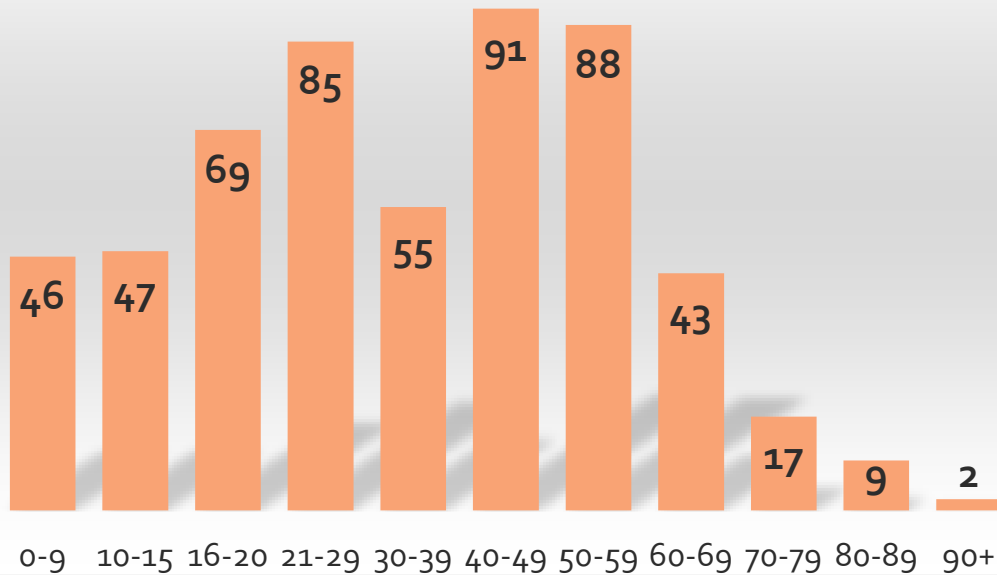

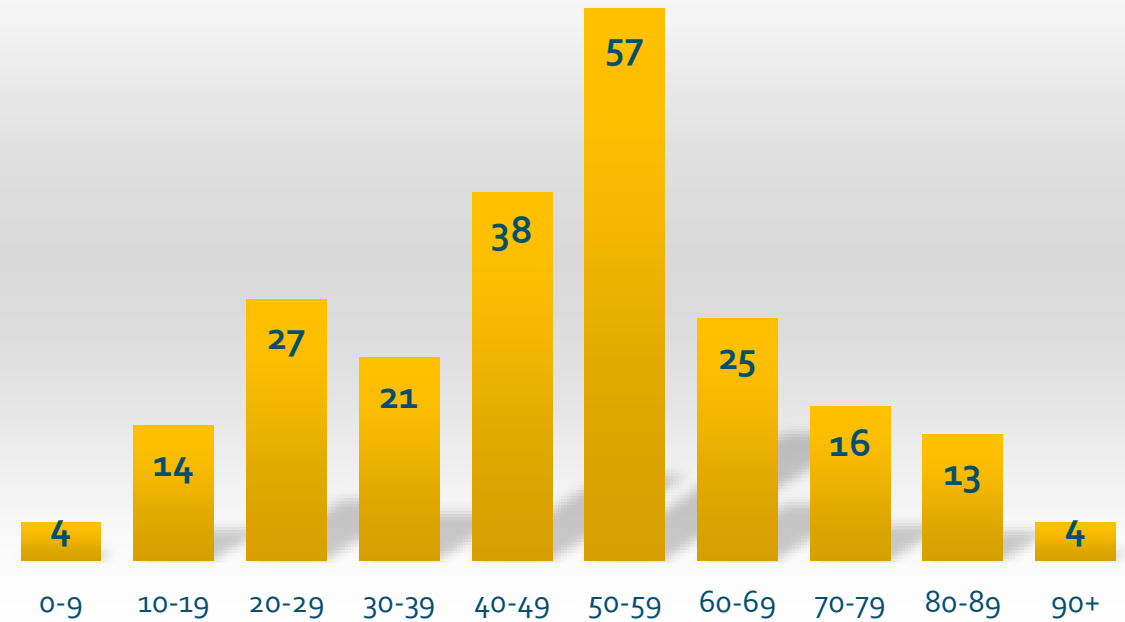


# POSITIVE COVID-19 CASES\* AGE DISTRIBUTION
